Park City, Utah - The 25th annual Huntsman Cup Nor Am will be hosted by the National Ability Center at Park City Mountain Resort on February 27th-28th, 2012. The Huntsman Cup is one of the nation's leading adaptive ski-racing events, bringing together a highly competitive field of racers from across the country and world.

The event will be held in the Eagle race arena, the same place the 2002 Winter Olympics racing was held, and will include two days of Giant Slalom and one day of Slalom racing. Over 50 athletes from across the US, Canada, Mexico and Great Britain are expected to compete in the Visually Impaired, Standing and Sitting categories.
